5. Read Colossians 4:5-6. According to these verses, why does our interaction with outsiders matter?
6. Some people have found that consistent trips to the same places of events and getting involved in community events are great ways to connect with outsiders. What do you think about these ideas, and can you think of any others?

### MOVING FORWARD

As we consider what we have discussed, it is important that we determine how to respond. Perhaps we can't invite, because we haven't been strategic about investing. This week, how can we invest into the lives of outsiders?
